Unauthorized Access to a Group Company

DaikyoNishikawa Corporation hereby announces that unauthorized access by a third party has been confirmed at one of its consolidated subsidiaries in Indonesia.

On March 26, 2026, abnormal activity was detected in certain systems of an overseas consolidated subsidiary. Following an investigation, we confirmed that unauthorized access by a third party had occurred. We immediately established an emergency response headquarters and, in cooperation with external experts, implemented appropriate security measures and recovery procedures. There has been no impact on production activities or product deliveries to customers.

Subsequently, on June 17, we confirmed that a portion of the data stored in the relevant systems had been transmitted externally.

In response to this matter, we have re-established its emergency response headquarters and are working with external cybersecurity experts to identify the cause and conduct a detailed investigation into the scope of the impact.

We are also taking measures to determine the full extent of the incident, protect our systems, and prevent recurrence.

As soon as we identify any new facts or impacts through the ongoing investigation, we will promptly notify the relevant parties and make announcements on our website and through other appropriate channels.

We sincerely apologize for the significant concern and inconvenience caused to its business partners and all other stakeholders.
